



Working with EDHEC Infrastructure Institute, LTIIA supports the development of long-term infrastructure performance benchmarks. Working with eFront, we are building software tools that help investors track their ESG compliance. LTIIA, together with the OECD and the GI Hub, is leading the Private Pillar of the G20 Infrastructure Data Initiative.

Together with our members, we produced ESG Handbook for long term investors in infrastructure. In the B2O context, LTIIA has promoted greater convergence in basic ESG definitions for infrastructure.
