The Covid-19 crisis risks fanning the flames of populism: much pain is being inflicted on the most vulnerable, unemployment is high, government debt is rising and budgets will be cut. In short, inequality is being exacerbated. The Impact Revolution can bring real change, not just in supporting our fight against Covid-19 but also in our recovery and in building a better world.

Impact must take its place at the centre of our economic system. Not only *should* this happen, it *can* happen, and it is *already* happening. Over the past two years, the ESG market has grown from \$22 trillion to \$31 trillion<sup>1</sup>, 15% of all the world's investable assets. Since 2016, the impact investment market has doubled each year. In 2017, it was estimated at \$230 billion; in 2018 it was \$502 billion;<sup>2</sup> and it is heading for the first \$1 trillion.

Preeminent international investor, entrepreneur, philanthropist, social finance innovator, and impact pioneer, Sir Ronald Cohen, has dedicated the past two decades to creating the most effective ways of achieving real social and environmental improvement. As one of the founders of venture capital, which ushered in the Tech Revolution, he builds on his years of personal experience to deliver a compelling account of how impact is capable of reshaping capitalism, to create the kind of word we want to live in.

Whether you're an aspiring entrepreneur, an established business leader, an investor, a philanthropist, or involved in government - or are just interested, as a consumer or employee, in companies doing good and doing well at the same time – this book is a sure fire way to find out how you can play a role in changing the world.

He has been described as "the father of British venture capital" and "the father of social investment". He is a graduate of Oxford University, where he was President of the Oxford Union. Today, Sir Ronald lives in Tel Aviv, London, and New York with his wife of more than thirty years, Sharon Harel-Cohen, who is a film producer. Sir Ronald's previous book *The Second Bounce of the Ball* explored how entrepreneurs can turn risk into opportunity, and was described by the FT as "One of the best books written on entrepreneurship in recent years."
